

#### Repairs,


Our project is aimed at developing and employing local content for high skilled labor.

#### 1. Competency development

Local communities are the vital key element in developing and building a successful and sustainable local content project. Competent local content are the future of the continuous in-country development of the local content project.

In the first phase we focus on increasing the competencies of local content up to a level that they are able to keep continuously self-develop their skills but also train and mentor others, as per international & stakeholders' requirements.





#### Verification of Competency

Verification Of Competency (VOC) is the process of gathering and analyzing evidence to support the relevance, accuracy, and utility of a person's competency. Validation ensures that a person's competency are based on impartial assessments and reflect the current competency level of a person, benchmarked on job and organization requirements, and meet local laws and standards.

With our VOC system candidates can have their current level of competency assessed and certified without any training required.

Certification that a certain good or product, imported or locally manufactured, has meet qualification criteria stipulated in contracts, laws & regulations, or end-user specifications.

Certification of (quality) systems Certification for ensuring that the process and the local organization of products & goods and services meet the required quality standards set by stakeholders and worldwide best practices.



#### 3. Services

The services projects are aimed to setup and implement a local content supported service company for various industries such as oil & gas and mining. Onsite and offsite services support companies in their maintenance and turn-around demands.

Together with our extensive network of worldwide service providers and experts we implement a knowledge transfer program for local content and local companies.





### 4. Repairs

Local repairs (manufacturing) can bring a lot of challenges. Over the years we have been involved in research of various local repairshops (manufacturing) initiatives and develop a solution for a viable and sustainable local repair facility.

Our project offers synergy in the manufacturing and repair processes all under one roof for various products and services. The main benefits of our approach are:

- Centralised location to benefit the logistics process.

- Remade local products to reduce waste and provide a "second life".






### Workshop facilities

Local repairs (manufacturing) require a suitable local workshop facilities for the maintenance and repair of equipment such as electric motors (High and Low voltage), valves, pumps, turbines, gaskets and seals, and other equipment.

The workshop facility will also have a custom designed machining-shop for manufacturing parts and products. With the capability to re-engineer parts via 3D-printing and FaroArm scanning.



### Future growth

Our local content development is aimed at delivering benefits beyond the payment of royalties and taxes. We take a strategic approach to local content efforts in recognition of the wider business benefits of creating and sharing value between local communities, government and in-country stakeholders for the long term.
